



Bio-based product, was defined by the United States Secretary of Agriculture in the Farm Security and Rural Investment Act of 2002 as follows:

"The term "bio-based product" means a product determined by the Secretary to be a commercial or industrial product (other than food or feed) that is composed, in whole or in significant part, of biological products, or renewable domestic agricultural materials (including plant, animal, and marine materials) or forestry materials.

AmeriZorb Throw and Go Products

AmeriZorb is a bio-based product. The primary component of AmeriZorb is peat moss. Peat moss is chemically very similar to trees and shrubs. The peat moss found in all three kinds of AmeriZorb, (Environmental, Professional and Super Absorbent) is composed of cellulose molecules. Trees and shrubs are also cellulose molecules.

AmeriZorb is environmentally friendly in the sense that it is both hydrophilic and bio-degradable. AmeriZorb therefore fits all of the parameters of a Bio-Based product.
